**Team Reports:**

GU12 Alire– Won their bracket in the champions' state cup – move on to quarter finals on April 24<sup>th</sup>. The girls are practicing 3 days a week.

GU14 Vukic – Our new coach is Leigh Cullip. The girl's seem to really like him and respond well to his coaching. He runs a very structured, professional practice. It seems like a positive change for the team.

GU15 – Advanced to elimination round and lost.

GU16 – Done! There are 4 injuries.

BU11 Alire – The boys have ended the spring season with a record of 6-1-0. We played in the Challenge Cup gold division 1 and finished 2<sup>nd</sup> in the bracket. We lost in the elimination round. The boys are looking forward to a good turnout at tryouts.

The BU14 Meherg "B" team participated in the Challenge Cup in April coming out 0-4. They struggled thru it with some roster difficulties due to prior family commitments. Many are looking forward to try outs coming up.

BU14 Krug 95 Red - We finished 1st in Division 2 with 7 wins, 1 loss and 1 tie. State Cup: Lost 2 and Won 1.

BU15B (16) Klusmann/Wedge - The boys are currently in HS soccer. We will begin practices in May, once HS is over. We are attending the following summer tournaments: Rainier Challenge Nike Crossfire Challenge, Oswego Nike Cup, Snohomish Bigfoot.

BU16 (17) Wedge- Boys are currently in HS season. Although there were only 5 returning players, they had a successful tryout and the roster is sitting at 17 players. Practice will resume in May.

**President's reports:**

Tryouts are occurring over the next five weeks. Email reminders for tryouts have been sent out. Feel free to forward information to anyone who is interested. Encourage current members and interested players to register ahead of time on-line. This will save time at the day of tryouts.

**Fundraising report:**

T-shirts order form is coming. Silverdale WA will be added to the shirts to increase our visibility to the community.

Applebee's dining date is next week. Email reminders will be sent out along with instructions to print the form and bring it with you to the restaurant. Our team will not get credit if you do not have the form! The mother's day baskets are questionable at this time – there might be an option to have "flats" of flowers.

Our mandatory participation club wide fundraising will include Emerald City Smoothie and Papa Murphy cards at 5 cards for \$25. Players have an option of either one or in combinations.

**Uniforms:** New uniforms are required! Team members with the old styles (including the red) will need to update.

**Treasurer Report:**

Our plan to get parents to bring their accounts forward is working for the moment – the player card "pulling" method is getting their attention. Time will tell if they will continue to pay as many have already paid their first payment and have discontinued once their child's team was finished with state cup. A question was asked regarding tryouts: can a player tryout if they have money due? Answer: yes they can tryout but they will not be able to attend practice unless a payment plan is in place. Our proposed budget for the new year is based on 22 teams.

**Registrar Report:**

Encourage families to register online prior to tryouts – this saves a lot of time at tryout registration and gets player on the field quicker. Also, encourage parents who are involved with the team to get their RMA forms (on-line through website) and turned in.

Registration night has been set for Wednesday April 28 from 6-8:30 at OSSC. Forms for specific age groups are online ready to download. Encourage families to fill them out and bring them to registration night to save time.

**Old Business:**

PDL continues to reorganize. The RCL has started a committee to work with the state. Decisions regarding the direction of the PDL are coming soon.

Fields and field access: we are continuing our work trying to secure the construction of turf fields with lights at Pendergast Park.

**New Business:** Due to tryouts and registrations occurring in April and May, it has been decided that we will not hold a May club meeting as only a few teams will have been established.

**Good of the game:**

Leigh Cullip is doing a U5-U8 coaching clinic. Coaches will receive a youth level coaching diploma.
